

# Wedding ceremony on the lawn.....

**\*\* Only available if Reception is also at Tamburlaine \*\***

Wedding ceremonies may be held on our beautiful lawn, and our wet weather alternative is the lawn-side deck.



## **Post ceremony timing.**

For the enjoyment of your guests, we recommend that the reception flows on immediately following the ceremony hour....

e.g. ceremony at 4.30pm, followed by canapés and pre-dinner drinks (which is the start of the 6 hour reception package) commencing at 5.30pm.

**BUT.....**



The cost of holding your ceremony on our beautiful lawn is **\$550**. This includes:



- 4 pews with white satin bows
- Garden arch
- Rose petal aisle
- Signing barrel
- Extra one hour of time and staffing before reception begins

If you plan to have a time gap between the ceremony and the reception for the bridal party to leave for photographs, but don't want your guests to have to leave the grounds, we suggest you choose one of these options for an early bar (i.e. a pre-reception package bar) for your guests.....

**\$6pp (1/2 an hour)** - includes additional time plus wine, beer, sparkling and soft drinks.

**\$12 pp (one hour)**

This cost can be added to your account or paid for on the day by credit card.

**OR**

Guests pay for their own drinks for this time.

The **maximum** time allowed for this early bar before food service commences is **one hour**.

# Fireworks!

Display costs start at \$1500 and will be confirmed on booking. Cost is all inclusive - it covers all grounds preparation, permits and licences, neighbourhood alerts, pyrotechnic supplies and licensed staff to conduct the display.

Note: Final approval must be obtained during summer period and fireworks may be cancelled if deemed unsafe by the Firechief during periods of firebans.
